CBL

CASE:

A 56 year old male presented in Emergency Department with altered mental status. Past medical history is significant for jaundice, anorexia and weakness for past few years. He has been constipated for the last week and had two episodes of bloody vomiting in last 3 months. On examination he is afebrile, has sclera icterus with mild jaundice. There are multiple spider nevi on upper abdomen and back. Abdominal exam reveals generalized distension of the abdomen without tenderness. Extremity exam reveals flapping tremors.

Vitals:

Temperature: 98 F

Pulse: 75 bpm

BP: 150/80 mmHg

R/R: 16/min
