Project Evaluation:

Phase 1: Written Report

A written report will carry 40% weightage of the final score. A panel of Academicians will be judging the projects and posters. Phase 1 score will have following distribution:

- Conformance with the proposal....(40%)
- Degree of innovation.....(60%)

Phase 2: Final Project Presentation

Project presentations/demonstration on the final day of the event will carry 60% of the score. Panel of Judges will consist of experts from both Academia and Industry. Phase 2 scoring will have following distribution.

- Total score carried from Phase 1.....(40%)
- Expected potential impact on local industry and economy.....(20%)
- Readiness for commercialization (prototype, business plan).....(20%)
- Presentation.....(20%)

Evaluation:

Projects and Posters will be short listed by scientific committee prior to exhibition.

PRIZES:

- Prizes will be awarded to top three (3) projects seperately for students and faculty and ten (10) posters selected by scientific committee.
- Certificates will be awarded to all participants of projects and postors.
