
Over the years, DUHS has built a distinguished tradition of excellence in education, research, and community service, playing a pivotal role in advancing healthcare across Pakistan.

DUHS is now ranked 14th in Pakistan—making it the only medical university to secure a place among the nation's top 15 in the UI GreenMetric Rankings 2025.


OICD also introduced a new IV Admixture and Compounding Pharmacy within its inpatient pharmacy, marking an important step toward enhancing medication safety and precision.





Equipped with advanced NAT-/NAAT and CLIA-based testing systems, the center ensures maximum accuracy in screening transfusion-transmissible infections. In the last year alone, around 50,000 NAAT-screened blood products were issued, reflecting its high service volume.



## Advanced Lympho-Venous Anastomosis Performed at Dow University Hospital

The Department of Plastic Surgery at Dow University Hospital has successfully performed Lympho-Venous Anastomosis (LVA), an advanced microsurgical procedure used in the treatment of lymphedema.

Conducted under 20x magnification with extremely fine 10/0 sutures, the procedure connects lymphatic vessels to tiny veins, helping restore natural lymphatic drainage.

LVA offers a minimally invasive option for patients, reducing swelling, improving mobility, and significantly enhancing overall quality of life.
