IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- Online submission of the application is mandatory, must be completed and submitted along with relevant documents.
- The online application processing fee is **Rs. 5,000/-** are **non-refundable**.
- Applications received after the last submission date will NOT be accepted. Strictly no personal contact, all correspondence to be done through email: spgs@duhs.edu.pk
- TA/DA will not be paid, nor will accommodation be provided to any candidate.
- Only candidates holding a **Sindh Domicile** are eligible to apply.
- Candidates employed in Government service must apply through the proper channel and submit a No Objection Certificate (**NOC**) at the time of application.
- Passing Marks: A minimum of 60% in each component is required to clear the Entry Test separately.
- The General and Subject-Specific Entrance Test (Tentatively) will be held on **Saturday, 03rd October 2026**.

ELIGIBILITY/ADMISSION CRITERIA:

- **Qualification:**
 - Minimum of 18-years of education in a relevant field from an HEC recognized institution.
- **CGPA:**
 - Minimum CGPA of 3.0 (out of 4.0) or 60% (in the annual system) in the MS/MPhil/equivalent degree from HEC-recognized higher education institution
- **GAT/HAT General Test:**
 - GRE/HAT General/Equivalent test, with a passing score of a minimum of 60%
 - Subject-specific Test:
 - Conducted by Dow University of Health Sciences
 - A passing score of a minimum of 60%
- **Doctoral Admission Committee Interview:**
 - Short-listed applicants only
 - Submission of a short research proposal in the area of the applicants' interest.
